ABOUT THE PROJECT

“YES, experience it yourself 4!” is the fourth edition of a 6 days training course for 24 youth workers or youth leaders which aims to empower them in the field of support and accompaniment of youth social entrepreneurial projects.

Since the last years in Europe, the promotion of entrepreneurship in youth work is a priority. Despite having good ideas, many young people don't know the necessary tools to develop their entrepreneurial social projects; they need to be supported and accompanied to put in practice these projects. It has also been found that many workers in the field of youth are well prepared to motivate these youngsters, but they are not sufficiently prepared to support the implementation of the projects.

That's why, in this TC, the participants will:

- Experiment in themselves the process of starting an entrepreneurial project.
 - Analyze the key factors about motivation and the difficulties of the process they will experience.
 - Empower themselves and increase their competences to be able to support the young people they are working with in these processes.
- During this project we will work with a wide spectrum of projects, from social local entrepreneurial projects to international projects, especially in the field of the Erasmus + programme.



Our objectives

- To give the opportunity to participants to learn key elements and concepts of being entrepreneurial and discover how to support entrepreneurship.
- To get familiar with concepts and tools and practice how to apply them and how to transfer them to the youngsters they are working with.
- To let participants identify their needs and next steps to improve their competences accompanying and supporting young entrepreneurs
- To create a network that will allow support, networking, cooperation and sharing of experiences among participants.

Participant's profile

- The target group is youth leaders and youth workers, willing to enhance their competences in the field of accompanying and supporting social entrepreneurship.
- Who are able to communicate and work in English fluently (which will be the working language for the whole training course)
- Who are able to attend the full training course.
- Who wish to learn and teach others during discussions or peer evaluation.
- Willing to share the learning outcomes of the TC in their organizations and local communities.

Methodology

The didactic methodology of the seminar will be based in three main points:

- Mix of theoretical inputs combined with practical exercises to allow the comprehension of the concepts and tools.
- Working with different learning methods based on non-formal education; like self-directed learning methods, reflection, peer to peer learning... to allow the transfer of the learning into different situations and into their reality.
- Using the existing resources in the TC: participants, trainers and real social entrepreneurial examples that we will get to know during the TC.



The venue

We will be staying in Los Batanes hostel in Rascafría, Madrid, one hour and a half far away from Madrid city centre. We will be accommodated in shared rooms with shared bathrooms. Most of them double, but according to the Venue needs we may have to use rooms of 3 or 4 people.

Rascafría is a very nice place, on the mountains and surrounded with nature and forest; a quiet place with a nice working atmosphere. All the other information, about what to bring and information of the weather, etc. will be given to the participants in another Info-pack.
